<u>Call to Order</u>: President Erin Thacker called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Attendance sheet is attached. Quorum present.

Guest Speaker: Bill Apperson, Apperson Education Products

- "Class Packs" by Apperson Education Products provides a fundraising opportunity for Briarwood as well as an easy way for parents to buy school supplies.
- Parents purchase required school supplies online, supplies are delivered to the school in time for Meet the Teacher Day in packs labeled with each student's name
- Shared items (copy paper, etc.) will be shipped in bulk
- School receives a 10% rebate on Class Packs that can be used to purchase school supplies for the rest of the year. As a pilot school for this program, Briarwood would be guaranteed \$1000 in school supplies.
- Free delivery, no cost to schools
- Prices are consistent with major online retailers and products include brand names (Elmer's, Crayola)
- There will be an option to contribute additional money to the school supply fund

Discussion – Based on reputation of company, convenience for parents, and the opportunity to earn \$1000 in school supplies, decision was made to accept offer.

MOTION (by Nicole Morgan) I move that we accept the offer to be a pilot school for the Class Packs Program through Apperson Education Products. Seconded by Rebekkah Leibowitz; no discussion; vote; Motion passes.
