Secretary's Report, Alison Larsson:

- Minutes from the General Meeting on May 18, 2015 were presented and approved as written.

Treasurer's Report, presented by Seung Park:

- Account Balances as of 4/30/16: Checking \$54,374.66 Savings \$15,051.36
- **2016-2017 Budget**: Budget committee (Erin Thacker, Alison Larsson, Seung Park, Laila Collins, Nicole Morgan) met on May 9.
 - We have a significant budget surplus that is going to be carried over, and there is a need for new laptops and carts. A new line item Laptops and Carts" was created with \$11,500 allocated.
 - Bear Path Bricks line item has been removed, it will only be promoted every other year for now
 - Pumpkin Carving Night has been removed and will only be held every other year.
 - The new line item of "Family Movie Nights" has been added
 - "Car Wash Tickets" line item has been removed and any car wash income will be added to the "Misc. Income/Donations" line item.
 - "Other PTA Support" line item has been changed to "ACT, Echo Glen"
 - "Gibson Ek donation" line item has been added for the \$250 one-time donation for the new Gibson Ek high school.
 - All Orange Ruler matching funds will be entered under Orange Ruler line item, it was previously added to Misc Income/Donations
